TRAP – Trail Riders Awards Program

This is the easiest program to participate in because all you need do is RIDE YOUR HORSE!

Hours spent on your horse outside the arena are logged and tracked each year which has proven invaluable many times when trails have been threatened to be closed to horses. When CSHA can instantly compile a list of riders or number of hours equestrians use a particular area or trail it is justification to those governmental agencies to continue maintaining trails.

Trail Trials –An obstacle course competition that tests the trail skills of horse and rider. Courses are several miles in length and reflect the diversity of California trials whether they are located on a ranch, public park, wilderness, beach, desert or urban setting.
