

HORSEMASTERSHIP

Horsemastership is an educational opportunity for equestrians to test their total knowledge of the horse. It is offered to members of the California State Horsemen's Association Inc.

There are five categories of competition to choose from:

English I (jumping 2'9); English II (flat only); Gymkhana (barrels & poles); Western (stock seat); Combined (jumping and stock seat)

Within each category there are two divisions:

- Junior less than 18 years of age
- Adult 18 years or older

The competition involves three tests, riding, grooming and a written test. Competition starts at the Region level, with the winners of all Regions competing for the CSHA State Championship title and the scholarship.

The deadline to sign up for the Region competition is April 15, 2015.
